

HOLA GHOST - A three piece duo..!

In 2012 the former drummer, a Roland TR 707 also known as "Ghost 707" was replaced by ex. Nekromantix drummer kristian Sandorff. Since then Hola Ghost has been touring and recording as a three piece duo..!

Description:

Mexican death-surf, digital psychobilly, dark disco, rock... - The music of the danish three piece act Hola Ghost has been categorised as all of the above plus more, and not without reason; appearing live with bandanas, bullet belts and sombrero, the trio fearlesly mix genres to create their own Scandinavian mariachi rock sound. Inspired by surf music, Mexican folklore, dark disco, psychobilly, B-western movies and what else is out there worth listening to. With mexican death masks face-painted, these three "Copenhagen gringos" present a high energy performance on albums as well as live on stage!

Biografi:

HOLA GHOST was formed as a duo by Peter Sandorff (ex Nekromantix and Mad Sin) with long time friend Jeppe B. Jessen, to work on the soundtrack for LA bound artist Gris Grimlys' debut movie "Cannibal Flesh Riot". Having no drummer, they bought a haunted drum machine in a pawn shop in Los Angeles, that the shop owner had won in a tequila-soaked poker game in Tijuana in Mexico. While working on the soundtrack the rythms started to seem colored by the machines Mexican origin. The Mexican influence and the high octane drum solo of the machine, that was given the name "Ghost 707", became trademarks for the bands two studio albums and live performances all over Europe, in USA and South America from 2005 until now. In 2012 however, Ghost 707 was replaced by former Nekromantix drummer Kristian Sandorff! - A drummer at least as tight as the previous one, but with two hands and legs of flesh and bone to juggle the wild rythms of Hola Ghost while adding backing vocals!

Hola Ghost is currently working on a 5 track EP to be released on vinyl later this year.
